April is National Donate Life Month (NDLM), and was established by Donate Life America and similar organizations in 2003. The Philadelphia area partner organization, Gift of Life Family House (aka Howie's House) is a mission partner of APC. Since 2011, Gift of Life Howie's House has served as a "home

away from home" for transplant patients and their families by providing temporary, affordable lodging and supportive services to those who travel to Philadelphia, for transplant-related care.

To support the mission of Howie's House, APC will be collecting travel-sized toiletries for guests during their stay, now through the end of May.


