While we are very happy for her, and will still see her around APC, this means we are seeking a new CE Coordinator. Please see the job description below and feel free to share with anyone you think might be interested!



Encounters with Jesus Pentecost Luncheon after worship on Sunday, May 19

The Christian Education Committee invites you to a luncheon discussion about the Adult Small Groups' favorite chapters of Timothy Keller's book, Encounters with Jesus. The class found the last 5 chapters of this book, particularly moving, involving pivotal events in Jesus' life that help us to understand the sheer beauty of

who Christ was, and what he has done for us. Keller encourages the reader to think of Jesus not primarily as a teacher, but as a savior, who did for us what we could not hope to do for ourselves.

Church Directory Update


On the bottom center of ardmorepres.org there is a link labelled "Church Directory" that will take you to the Instant Church
